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Modes of Coaching – Four Plans Introduced

Plan	Description	Ideal For
01	On-Site Lesson (Only 1 day per week)	Players who prefer in-person training with limited time commitment.
02	On-Site Lessons (2 days per week – Selected Players Only)	Players demonstrate a higher level of commitment and progress.
03	Online Lesson Only (1 day per week)	Players who prefer the flexibility of remote learning.
04	On-Site + Online Lessons	Players seeking a comprehensive experience with both in-person and online sessions.

Players may choose any of the above plans.

FEES STRUCTURE

Monthly Coach's Fee: Rs. 3,000/-

A/C Room, Desk, and Chair Fee: Rs. 1,500/-

The coach's and room fees must be deposited into the specified account by the 10th of each month. To confirm the transaction, submit the payment slip via WhatsApp.

Facility Fee (Additional Charge):

The facility fee must be paid separately every six months and covers updated lessons, additional tests and exams, monthly player reports (based on games), and access to chess clocks, projectors, and materials.

Breakdown:

• 1st Six Months: Rs. 5,000/-

• 2nd Six Months: Rs. 4,500/-

• 3rd Six Months: Rs. 3,500/-

4th Six Months: Rs. 2,500/-

ATTENDANCE, PAYMENT, DEDUCTIONS, AND KEYNOTE:

The **coach's and facility fees are fixed** and **do not change** based on how many lessons you attend. These fees include full individual coaching. If players miss any lessons, they can join **catch-up lessons** at no extra cost.

We understand that schedules can be busy, but we kindly ask all players to attend regularly and pay on time. We cannot accept players who attend irregularly or make late payments. This policy helps us ensure that every player gets the full benefit of the coaching and maintains a smooth running of the classes.

Please note that we have provided all possible deductions to support the players and ensure they get the best value for their commitment.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Please note that there will NOT be any available scholarships for this course. Instead, we have upgraded all chess lessons in 2025 with the latest materials. We plan to teach them all international lessons, a minimum of \$150\$—\$200\$.

CHILD PROTECTION RULES

ACTIVE PLAYERS

- 1. Auto-Registration: All players participating in the previous course have been automatically enrolled in the same group with Plan 01.
- 2. Changing the Plan: Please inform us within this week about your fixed practice day and selected plan.

INACTIVE PLAYERS

Status: Inactive players will be added to the "My Chess Champs" group, where they can resume lessons in the next course or receive assistance anytime.

Inactive Status Criteria: All players will be inactive if they are absent for **two consecutive days** without prior notice and fail to communicate with us.

Plan 02: On-Site Lessons (2 days per week)

(This is not Compulsory)

All fees as in **Plan 01**, plus the following additional fees:

1. Extra Coach's Fee: Rs. 2500/-

2. A/C Room, Desk, and Chair Fee: Rs. 1,500/-

3. No other additional fees.

4. Maximum total fee: Rs. 8500/- per month.
